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Grim and Tucker are the co-authors of a new overview of the field titled <u>Ecology and Religion</u> (Island Press, 2014). Grim, Tucker, and Willis Jenkins co-edited the <u>Routledge Handbook on Religion and Ecology</u> (Routledge, 2016).
