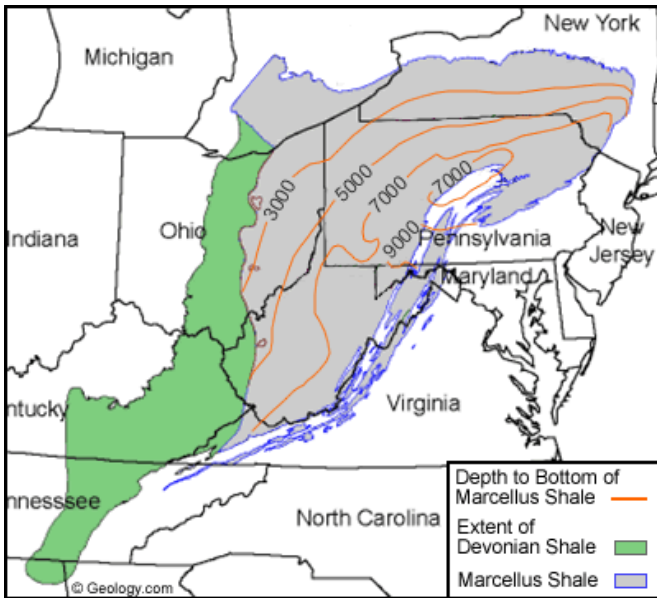


# A Silence of the Lambs –
