Interreligious Ecological Action A Special Issue of *Studies in Interreligious Dialogue*

We are seeking 5,000-7,000-word scholarly essays from various academic disciplines for a special issue of the *SID* that will focus on interreligious cooperation and discourse on environmental and environmental justice issues. The inter-religiosity of the topic can also include religious groups and secular groups working together. Consideration of the “ecology” of interreligious dialogue is also welcome: what works, what doesn’t, how such interactions change religions, etc. We are particularly interested in applied interreligious cooperation surrounding protests such as the Dakota Pipeline or in groups such as Extinction Rebellion, the interreligious nature of Pan Indigenous movements or organizations such as “Faith for the Earth” and “Interfaith Rainforest,” the interreligious work that is happening around the *Laudato Si* initiative, and the critical (post/de colonial and other) issues that emerge from doing interreligious work. All geographical regions will be considered.

These essays should be submitted by December 31, 2022, to be considered for this 2023 issue. If you have an idea for an essay, you are encouraged to contact one of the editors about your idea.
